# Pack 80 Uniform Guide

We feel that purchasing a uniform should not be a barrier to joining in on the fun and a Field Uniform (Class A) is not mandatory but highly recomended. Each scout is provided an Activity Shirt(Class B) upon registration and additional shirts are available for purchase for the scout, sibblings, or family to wear at activities if they choose to.

Official scout uniforms may only be worn by registered members of Scouting America.

### Why are uniforms so important

Wearing uniforms has been a method of the Scouting movement from the beginning. Decades of experience show uniforming to have many benefits, including these:

- Equality. The uniform represents a democratic ideal of equality. Youth from various cultures and different economic levels wear the same uniform and cooperate as equals.
- Identification. The uniform identifies a youth as a member of the Cub Scouts. Badges on the uniform tell other
  members that he or she belongs to their den, pack, and council. The uniform itself identifies a good citizen to the
  entire community.
- Achievement. The uniform displays badges and other awards so the accomplishments of each Cub Scout can be immediately recognized.
- Commitment. Wearing a uniform is a constant reminder to each Cub Scout of their commitment to the ideals and purposes of Cub Scouting: duty to God, loyalty to country, and helpfulness to others.

### **Activity Uniform (Class B)**

START WITH THIS OPTION

Our pack has designed custom t-shirts to be worn by scouts underneath their Class A uniforms as well as for parents and siblings. Wearing your Class B t-shirt helps to differentiate our scouts, parents, leaders, and siblings from the crowd during a campout or outing. They also look great and show your pride in your pack! We wear these to events where we will get dirty or be playing.

#### **Class B Parts**

- 1. Pack T-shirt
- 2. Neckerchief
- 3. Hat
- 4. Belt

### Field Uniform Parts (Class A)

<u>BUILD THIS UNIFORM OVER TIME AS YOU GROW IN SCOUTS</u>
This is the classic Cub Scout uniform is worn to <u>most</u> scout events.

\*\*\* Lions may use the Official Lion Scout T-Shirt as their Class A. The neckerchief and hat are optional but suggested. \*\*\*

- 1. Hat worn bill forward, straight on your head.
- 2. Shirt long or short sleeved, buttoned-up and tucked-in, always. A t-shirt should be worn underneath at all times so that the Class A can be removed for messy or sweaty activities (such as painting, sports, etc.)
- 3. Neckerchief & Slide
- 4. Belt cut to length, but leave it a little longer to grow with them through the ranks.
- 5. Shoes & Socks no sandals or flip flops, shoes must be closed heel and toe for safety. Crocks are popular, but save those for camping or the beach
- 6. Insignia / Patches Please DO NOT use Badge Magic or other iron-on or wet type of fabric glue to attach the patches to your scout's uniform. If the patch is placed incorrectly or needs to be moved, the patch can come off but the glue residue leaves a mess behind and is there forever. Please only use needle and thread to sew on the patches. The scout shop offers sewing servies, or reach out to your Den Leader to see if another parent can help.
- 7. Pants/Shorts/Skirt with belt loops, official BSA pants are optional but the pants you choose, if purchased from another store, should be the same navy blue color.

The best place to start is the Class B Shirt. Then add the Hat, Neckerchief, and Belt. Next add the uniform shirt.

## Pack 80 Uniform Guide

The badges of rank for Lion, Tiger, Wolf, and Bear go on the left pocket of the blue shirt as shown in the image above. They are placed in this order:

- First Rank Badge Earned 12:00 Position
- Second Rank Badge Earned 9:00 Position
- Third Rank Badge Earned 3:00 Position
- Fourth Rank Badge Earned 6:00 Position












fourth is placed in position 4.
